Evanina and the band will celebrate the release of their latest record, The Pennsylvania Merry Makers Reunion, with a one-time only polka dance on June 30 in Mayfield. The 16 tracks are all arranged by Evanina and feature original and traditional polkas. Whether it's opening for Bobby Vinton in front of 10,000 people or getting their fans out of the house for one more dance, The Pennsylvania Merrymakers are here to celebrate.
